

Voice Recorder with ANDROID



1. Download the **Voice Recorder** App for Android. The logo looks like this:
(click on link to download app or visit your Android app store on your device.)

Configure Settings


- 2) Now that you have downloaded the APP, let's get your settings configured. Click on **Settings** at the top right corner of the screen. You will only need to do this part of the instructions once. Configure as follows:

GENERAL

Record Format **AMR (3gp) - Small Files (mp3 is better if you can)**

Sample Rate **44KHz - CD Quality**

Encoder bitrate **128 kbps**



ADVANCED

Ask for filename **(Make sure this box is checked)**

Record Stereo **(Make sure this box is checked)**

Record on start **(uncheck this box)**


LED notification **(Make sure this box is checked)**

Stop when low memory **(Make sure this box is checked)**

Stop on call **(Make sure this box is checked)**

Screen on **(Make sure this box is checked)**

Add to library **(Make sure this box is checked)**



RECORD

When recording, make sure you're in a quiet room. The microphone is extremely sensitive and will pick up the sound of a refrigerator, fan and any buzzing noise. Speak directly into the microphone, with your mouth about 8 inches from the phone. Speak

clearly and keep going, even if you make an error. After all, though you're recording for later airplay, it's good to sound as live as possible. NOTE: Some voice artists place a cardboard box in front of them to create a "studio booth" ambience. Run through your script before you record. Have fun recording!



1. Hit the **Recorder** tab on the top left of your screen.
2. Press the **Record** button
3. Start speaking once the timer says 00:02 seconds
4. Once you have completed your recording hit the **Stop** tab (Be sure to leave 2 seconds of blank space after your recording)
5. A pop-up will appear titled "Recording name" IMMEDIATELY **rename your file** and hit the **create** tab

All files are named with your "**RadioShowName**", **RadioShowAirDate**, and **TalkBreakNumber**. There are 3 talk breaks per hour, and 12 talk breaks per four hour show.



EMAIL YOUR FILES

Make sure your player tab is highlighted.


1. Click the boxes on the left of your files to put check marks in them.
(If you have a 4 hour show there are 12 files. If you have a 2 hour show there should be 6 files to send. You speak 3times per hour / 15, 30 and 45 past the hour).



2. At the very top right corner of your screen select the share icon:



3. Options for you to send your files will appear.
